
You had enquired of me previously if the Nexus paper on the above subject was to be published. The question was raised at a recent meeting of the Limerick Regeneration Community Consultative Forum, which was attended by Representatives of Limerick City Council, Representatives of the Residents Fora from each of the Limerick Regeneration Areas as well as PAUL Partnership.

I am writing to inform you that it was decided at the Forum that, while the options paper had made some suggestions for the development of community based structures, no decisions have been made and this paper is now part of an ongoing piece of work supported by SSIRL (Supporting Social Inclusion & Regeneration in Limerick) and it might be misleading to publish. In particular concern was expressed that publishing might lead some to believe that decisions had already been made and this is clearly not the case.

The only decision (made at the recent Forum Meeting) that has been taken as a result of the suggestions made in the Nexus paper has been to establish an Estate Management Development Group to take this work forward. This work is to be led by Steve McNamara of Limerick City Council, though no meeting has taken place to date. The group will consist of Limerick City Council, PAUL Partnership and Representatives from each of the Regeneration Residents Fora. One of the tasks of this group will be to identify how to best communicate and consult with residents.
